---

Don't throw batteries in the trash! Battery collection bins are located in or near the main lobby (1st floor) of many campus buildings.

## 02

---

All types of batteries are accepted for recycling, including single-use alkaline batteries (AA, AAA, C, D and 9 volt), button batteries, and rechargeable batteries.

## 03

---

For larger batteries used in laptops, cameras, power tools, and uninterruptable power supplies, please submit a Facilities work request for separate pickup. These include nickel-cadmium, lithium-ion, and lead-acid batteries.
