All types of batteries are accepted for recycling, including single-use alkaline batteries (AA, AAA, C, D and 9 volt), button batteries, and rechargeable batteries.

For larger batteries used in laptops, cameras, power tools, and uninterruptable power supplies, please submit a Facilities work request for separate pickup. These include nickel-cadmium, lithiumion, and lead-acid batteries.
